
Learning Target: Students will identify and create shapes.

Let's Get Started:

Watch Video: Shapes for Kids by: Jack Hartmann

Practice: Name these shapes.







Activity:

Shoelace Shapes

Materials needed: Paper, marker, 20 inch shoelace or string

- 1. Draw a shape or lines.
- 2. Have your child trace their shape with the shoelace/string.
- 3. Ask your child:
 - a. What shapes did I draw?
 - b. What do you notice about the lines?
- 4. Continue the activity drawing different shapes and lines.
- 5. Have your child draw shapes and lines.
- 6. Ask your child:
 - a. What lines did you draw?
 - b. What shapes did you draw?
 - c. How are the shapes you drew different?
 - d. How are the shapes you drew the same?

Another way to create shapes is to soak yarn in glue and let it dry on a piece wax paper.
