Learning Target:
Students will identify what worms need.

Let's Get Started:

Practice: Is a Worm an Insect?



A Worm is NOT an Insect

Activity:

What worms need

Materials needed: glass jar/vase, dirt, sand, worms, one piece of black construction paper

- 1. Make a worm habitat using a glass jar/vase
 - a. Place plastic wrapped cardboard tube in the middle
 - b. Alternate layers of sand and dirt
 - c. Add some worms from outside
 - d. Add food for worms (bits of vegetables)
 - e. Mist tower every few days to keep soil damp
 - f. Wrap a black piece of construction paper around the vase to keep it dark
- 2. You can remove it periodically to view worms.
- 3. Ask your child:
 - a. What do worms need? (food, water/damp, dark)
 - b. What do you notice?
