Activity:

Measurement

Materials needed: 3 toys, paper clips, or lego pieces that are the same size.

1. Have your child get 3 toys.
2. Select either paper clips of same size lego pieces for your measuring tool.
3. Have your child measure the toys length with the measuring tools.
4. Ask your child:
 - a. How many (measuring tool) long is that toy?
 - b. Which toy is the longest?
 - c. Which toy is the shortest?
 - d. What toy do you have that you think would be the longest to measure?
