
Pre-K Science Lesson: 04/28/2020

Activity

Water Cycle in a Bag

Materials needed: Ziploc baggie, tape, blue food coloring (optional), marker (optional), water

- 1. Have your child draw on the bag a sun, clouds, and water.
- 2. Add a small amount of water to the baggie.
- 3. Add a few drops of blue food coloring.
- 4. Hang on a sunny window.
- 5. Observe over the next day.
- 6. Ask your child:
 - a. What do you see happening?
 - b. Why is that happening?
 - c. Why are there blue drops on the top of the bag?
