Learning Target:


Students will learn about the parts of a tree.

Let's Get Started:

Watch Video: <u>Head Shoulders Knees and Toes for Trees!</u>

Practice:

Name the different parts of a tree you see.



Activity:

Observational Drawing of a Tree

Materials needed: Paper, writing utensil

- 1. Have your child find a tree to observe and draw.
- 2. Ask your child:
 - a. What do you notice about the trunk of the tree?
 - b. What shape is the leaf?
 - c. Are there any animals in the tree?
 - d. What animal might live in the tree?
- 3. Assist your child with pointing out and labeling the different parts of their tree.

Another way to explore would be to create the tree using play dough!
