Activity:

Tornado In A Jar

Materials needed: Jar or bottle, water, liquid soap, vinegar, paper and pencil

1. Watch video for activity demonstration: [Tornado in a Jar](#)
2. After creating the Tornado in a Jar, have your child swirl it.
3. Ask your child:
 - a. What do you see happening?
 - b. Why do you think that's happening?
4. Have your child draw what they see.

Another way to explore is to add a few drops of food coloring or some glitter and have your child observe what they see.
