# Activity:

## Smack the Number

**Materials needed:** Dice, paper or post it notes, spatula or fly swatter

\*if you don't have a dice, you can just write numbers 1-6 on a piece of paper and then your child can draw a piece of paper instead of rolling\*

1. Write the numbers 1-6 on separate pieces of paper and spread it out on the table.
2. Have your child roll a dice, or draw a piece of paper and look for that number on the table.
3. Once your child locates the number have them smack it with a spatula or fly swatter.
4. Have your child continue playing until they've identified all the numbers.

Another way is to use objects that they have to count in a pile instead of the number, and then they could smack the objects instead of the paper.
