2nd grade Math Lesson: April 6, 2020

Learning Target:

Students will say the time shown on a digital clock saying the hour and the minute and relate it to an analog clock with the same time.

Background: This is a review lesson for time.


- Students will review reading time to the hour and $\frac{1}{2}$ hour.
- Students will review vocabulary related to time.
- Students will learn the difference between analog clocks and digital clocks.

Practice #1: What do you notice about these clocks?







Practice #1:

What time does the clock show?






