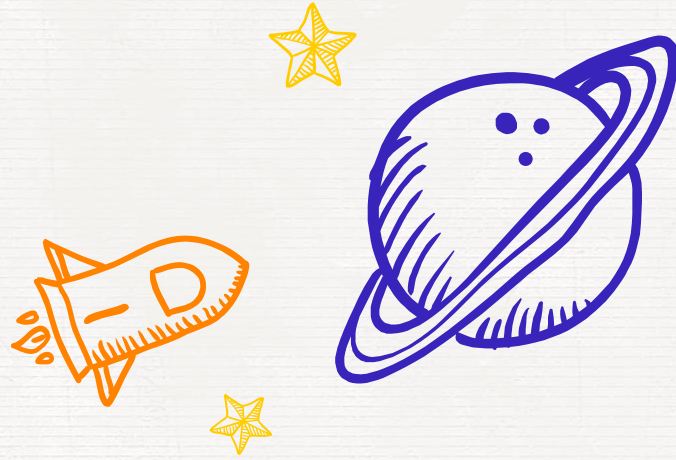

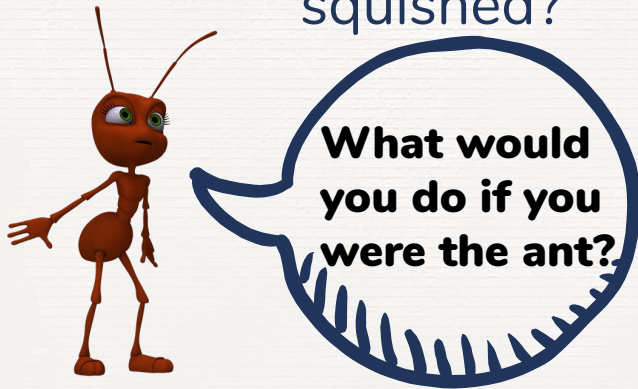


# Practice #1
