Learning Target:

I can perform a varied repertoire of songs...representing diverse cultures, genres and styles (P5)

Background: Songs and movement (dance)

- Students move to a song
- Students learn dance moves to a popular song

Do you like to dance? If so, do you like to do your own dance moves? Have you ever done a line dance (This is where everyone does the same thing in the song...dancing in unison)?

Information:

Line dances are group dances where everyone does the same moves, but there isn't any contact with each other.

Usually, the dance is repetitive with a few moves occurring over and over.

Line dances have been extremely popular for many, many years. Examples of line dances are:

The Chicken Dance, The Macarena, The Electric Slide,
The Cha Cha Slide & The Cupid Shuffle

More Information:

Almost every genre of popular music has line dances. You can find line dances for country music, hip hop, R&B, pop, and more. You can even find line dances for the less “popular” genres, such as polka, Mexican, Italian, etc.

Example of Line Dance:

Here is a line dance to Old Town Road. See if you can do it!
