Someone is bothering you. They make funny faces and say mean things. Your feelings are hurt and you are starting to get angry.

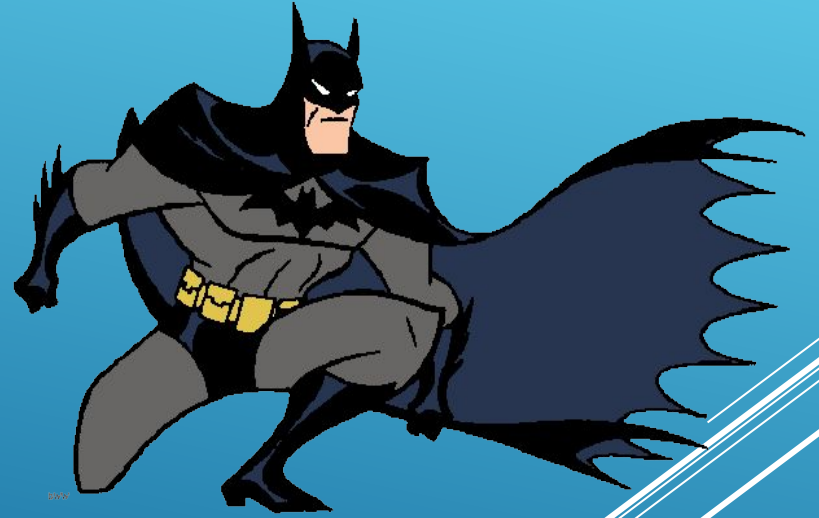
What can you do?

Your Action

- Yell at them until they stop

Results

- You have the adults attention
- You both get in trouble
- You are feeling angry and can't relax



Villain

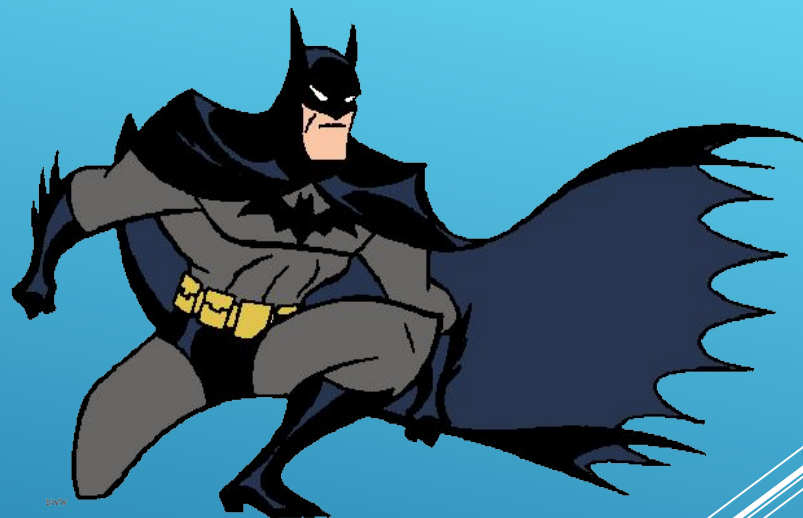
Now take a look at a different path...

Your Action

- Let it go and try to ignore them
- Try to communicate that they are making you angry
- Ask for help from an adult if they keep going

Results

- It isn't worth getting in trouble
- Move away from them
- You feel good, get to have free time AND stay out of trouble



Hero

Reflect on your behavior and actions when you are at your best and at your worst.

What are the benefits of going down the Hero path?
