3rd Grade: Teamwork/Cooperation




Share 3 ways you cooperate at home with someone in your house.

HOW IT WORKS:

- In pairs, you will each have a set of matching legos
- You will need to divide these equally so you have the exact same legos
- The person with the earliest birthday will go first.
- Give specific instructions on where to place the legos.
- After 5 minutes look and see how you did then switch!

HINTS:

- Use directional words
- Be nice and polite
- Ask clarifying questions (do you understand?, what side of the board?, horizontal/perpendicular?)
- Cheer for your partner
- Don't be afraid to tell your partner to slow down or you don't get it!
