Economic Terms Directions: Decide which picture belongs with each term. There will be 2 pictures for each term. Remember, <u>consumers</u> are people that make purchases.









#### Practice #2:

<u>Natural</u>- comes from nature <u>Capital</u>- goods purchased to help make other goods/services <u>Human</u>- workers


