

Remember, plants need 5 things to survive.



From the worksheet:


- 1. (Answers vary) A seed that travels by water to land is a coconut seed.
- Animals help to plant seeds because they are "hitchhikers" and travel on an animal or insect.
- 3. Seeds can travel in the air by the wind scattering smaller seeds that have wings or are feather like. Some of them are blown into places that can germinate. (For example, helicopters.)
- 4. Another way seeds can spread is seeds can drop out of a flower onto the ground.
