**Learning Target:**  
Students will tell time to the nearest minute

**Background: We are reviewing what we learned yesterday and continuing to practice on telling time to the nearest minute.**

- Students learn to tell time by the hour and  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour in 1st grade
- Students learn to tell time to the nearest 5 minutes in 2nd grade
- Students learn to tell time to the nearest 1 minute in 3rd grade.

5, 10, 15, 20





