
Let's Get Started:

What are...homophones?

homo= same phone= sounds

So....

homophone = to sound the same

Suffix Focus: -ly (how something is done)

perfectly- in a manner or way that could not be better (adverb)

suddenly- happening fast and without warning (adverb)


The students were *perfectly* sitting in their chairs.
