4th Grade Social Studies Lesson: April 7th, 2020

Learning Target:

Students will locate and describe the <u>West</u> and <u>Southwest</u> regions of the United States.

Background:

This is a review lesson from Quarter 1 of Fourth Grade.

- In 2nd grade, students learn to read and construct maps.
- In 3rd grade, students learn to identify major cities, rivers, and regions of Missouri.
- In 4th grade, students learn to name and locate specific regions, states, capitals, river systems, and mountain ranges in the U.S.




Today, you will learn about 2


regions: West and Southwest.









2. Which number marks the **Southwest** region of the U.S. on the map?






