# **Background:**

- In 4th grade, students learn to name and locate specific regions, states, capitals, river systems, and mountain ranges in the U.S.


# Let's get started!

**Recall** from yesterday you learned about 2 of the 5 regions in the United States. Review them here.


Today, you will learn about another region: the Midwest.




