Learning Target:

Students will locate and describe the **Southeast** region of the United States.

Background:

- In 4th grade, students learn to name and locate specific regions, states, capitals, river systems, and mountain ranges in the U.S.


Let's get started!

Don't forget that there are 5 regions in the United States! Review them here.


Today, you will learn about one of these regions: The Southeast.


First, go on a <u>Virtual Trip</u> to the South East!

Next, watch the <u>Southeast Video</u>.









