Learning Targets:

Students will define the term "instrumental ensemble".

Students will classify a large ensemble.

Students will **classify the instruments** of the **orchestra** by the method of sound production.



4th Grade Music Lesson: Ensemble #3: Orchestra

- A group of people singing and/or playing together is called an ensemble (pronounced on-som-bul).
- If the ensemble has 18 people or less it is referred to as a small ensemble and more than 18 is considered a large ensemble.
- The orchestra is a large ensemble.

Lesson: Ensemble #1: Marching Band (April 2, 2020)

- The orchestra is the oldest of the instrumental large ensembles dating back to the 1600's.
- The orchestra plays classical music but they have begun to play much contemporary music, too.
- 20+ members play various instruments from the String, Woodwind, Brass, and Percussion families.
