

Warm Up:

Political revolutions happen when people are tired of how their current government is running things and feel that the only way they can make it change is through a violent take over.

Write a brief paragraph explaining why the people of Russia would have wanted to revolt against their government.



Warm Up:

The Tsars of Russia were monarchs who ruled with total authority. The people of Russia had little voice in their government. Although some of them did things to help Russia, they often hurt many of the people at the same time. Peasants were basically turned into slaves. Independent kingdoms were conquered and forced to pay tribute to them. Even when they were given the right to vote and have a voice, nobles could restrict those rights, or even have them killed. Eventually, the people grew weary of being stomped on and Nicholas II was overthrown.

The Bolshevik Revolution in Russia promised that all people would be equal.

Individuals would not struggle against each other for food, education, or wealth.

Activity 1: Joseph Stalin (People's Leader or Just Another Tsar)

- Manipulated role as General Secretary to gain power
- Had Trotsky exiled
- Effectively became dictator of Soviet Union
- Workers who didn't meet targets were executed
- Took land from peasants to make collective farms
- Everyone had to praise him
- Picture was in every school and factory
- Killed people who threatened his power
- Executed generals and admirals
- 20 million citizens sent to gulags
- Eastern Europe became satellite states
- Tortured his doctors
- Had secret police investigate Politburo










