- What are some of the examples of theme that is described in the video?





 - → Select one of the themes you create that encompasses Steve Jobs' Commencement speech and find textual evidence to support the theme. Explain how the text supports the theme you created

Practice Answer Key:

(Answers will Vary)

- Check your answer to make sure it meets the following criteria:
 - → Did you write in complete sentences?
 - → Did you use standard conventions (spelling, punctuation, grammar)?
 - → Did you answer the question?
 - → Did you support and explain your answer using 2 details from the article and 2 details from the video?

Sample Proficient Answer:

Anyone can obtain success with determination, working through unexpected changes and passion. Steve Jobs' commencement speech describes the struggles he face in his life and also emphasizes that anyone can be successful if they take advantage of change. Jobs states, "And then I got fired. How can you get fired from a company you started?" (11). Even though he was rejected from his own company, he used this change as motivation to be even more successful than before. He goes on to declare, "I didn't see it then, but it turned out that getting fired from Apple was the best thing that could have ever happened to me. " (13). After the failure with Apple, Jobs followed his passion, worked hard and found success outside of Apple with Pixar and NeXT. Anyone can be successful if they remain passionate, determined and use changes in life as motivation.
