LEARN

Sometimes when trying to figure out the meaning of new words, it is helpful to look at the different parts of a word to help you.

Common prefixes, suffixes, and root words are often clues to what a word might mean.



Putting the Parts Together



PREFIX

Where: at the beginning
Examples: pre-, sub-, mini-
Sample Words: preview, minimum

SUFFIX

Where: at the end
Examples: -ly, -able, -ness
Sample Words: workable, coldness

ROOT

Where: anywhere
Examples: -geo-, -photo-, -chron-
Sample Words: geography




LEARN


Some examples:

The prefix -re means again or back.


I need to replenish my supply of pens; many of my favorite pens have run dry.



Re = again or
back



My pens have
run dry



Replenish must
mean stock
again

I need to get more pens.

LEARN

Some examples:

The suffix -ly means “in a certain way”

The patient watched anxiously as the doctor read her temperature.

“Ly” means in
a certain way



Waiting for
doctor to read
temperature



Anxiously must
mean in a way
showing anxiety

The patient is nervous about what the temperature might be!

Desperate - in great need

Desperately- in a way that shows great need

The young woman with a flat tire was *desperately* calling for a tow truck.

Grateful - thankful

Gratefully - in a thankful way

When a fellow motorist stopped to change her tire, she *gratefully* tipped him generously.
