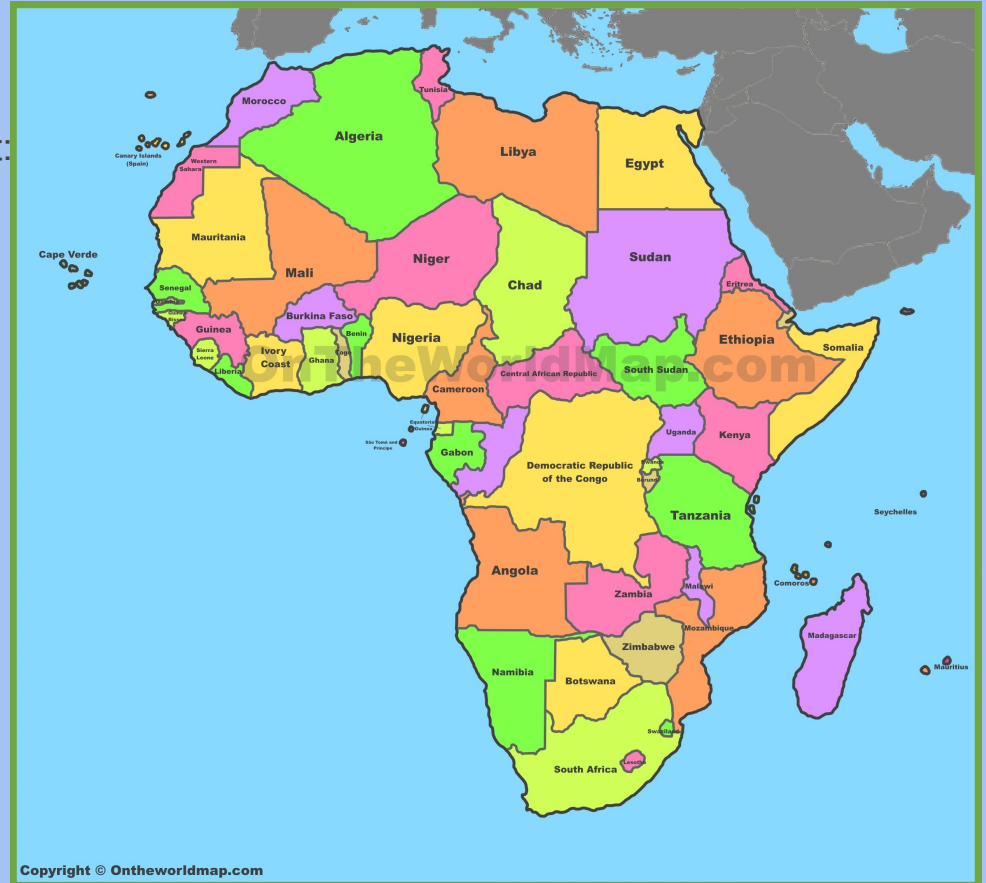

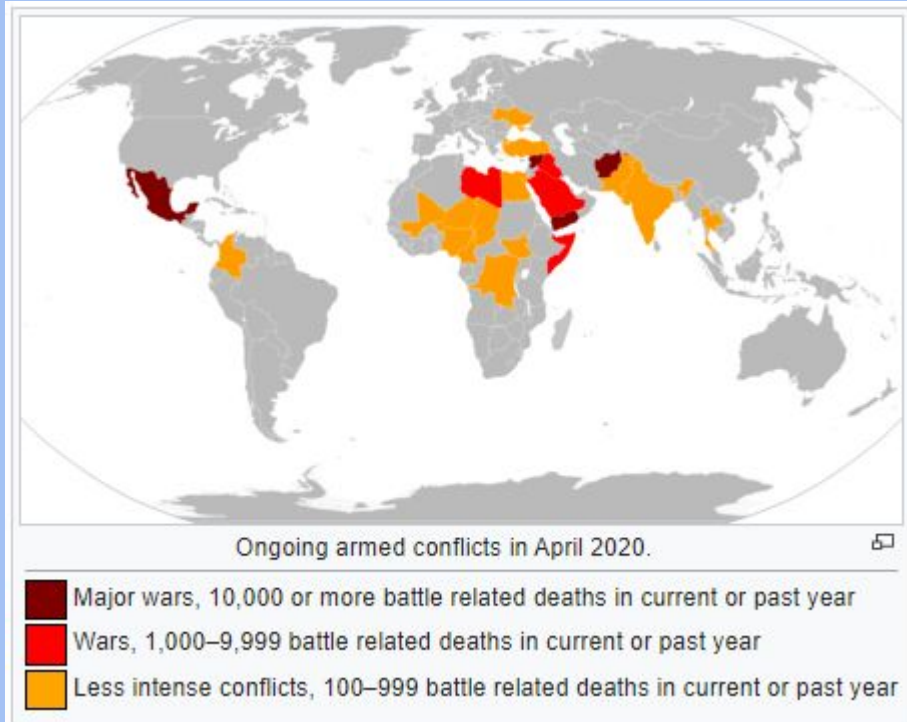
1. When did the civil war in South Sudan begin?
