## Lesson Activity Answer key

- Disorder that cause multiple separate personalities
- Hysterical neurosis; first published in DSM-III (aka multiple personality disorder would be acceptable answer to other names too)
- 3. Causes: childhood trauma, emotional, sexual or physical abuse, environmental factors. Symptoms: significant memory loss, out of body experience, depression, anxiety, thoughts of suicide
- Psychotherapy (CBT; DBT), EMDR, medications
