Take images of forced perspective using the brainstorming from the first day of this project.

Bell Ringer

How can you still use composition while taking forced perspective photos?

Lesson/Activity

Manipulation perspective in your photography can create an interesting dialogue between the subject and objects surrounding it. Can you make something really small look big? Can you make something really big look small? Find objects or places where you can use yourself or someone else to alter the perspective/scaling of objects.

How to take forced perspective photos

1) The more distance between the subject and object the more dramatic the perspective can

change.

2) Different angles can produce altered perspective and scaling, try getting extremely low angles

(camera pointing up) or extremely high angles (camera pointing down).

3) Take photos from multiple different angles to see what perspective looks best with your subject.

Take 5 different forced perspective photos focusing on large objects looking smaller than they actually are.
