**Requirements**: The images should display appropriate exposure, composition, etc...for the selected subject. Images may be from a cellphone or camera. Photos can not have anything copy and pasted in to display Trick Scale. Trick Scale should be done through the camera lens. Editing is limited to cropping and exposure or any other creativity that does not interfere with the concept of Trick Scale.
