Day Four: Creative Practice

Objective/Learning Target: After completing this activity, you will better understand typography and be able to create a unique and interesting typography design.

Requirements: Printed worksheet for the Alphabet 100 (<u>link here</u>) or plain paper, and a pencil.

Bellringer/Warm Up: It would be easy to feel like you are out of ideas at this point. Look at the letterforms you have so far. Could you use an earlier idea and make an improvement based on the same theme? Can you use some of the ideas from earlier and use the opposite to create more examples? Can you make letters look like the letter while only using parts of the letter?

Instructions: Using the <u>template</u> from before, or a plain piece of paper, create the final 25 unique examples of the letter you have chosen.

Be as creative as you can, but keep the design closely resembling the intended character.
