Objective: Students will study pencils, transform them, and learn to see No. 2 pencils in a new way. They will maintain the color of the traditional pencil: yellow, with black lettering and a pink eraser.

Requirements: Pencil, Paper, Colored Pencils, Black fine-tipped marker or felt pen, and ChromeBook

Check for Understanding:





