Objective/Learning Target:

Students will

- draw from observation make several studies of the keyhole
- work on proportion
- explore different visions that relate to their lives

Inspiration: We will look at examples of old ornate keyholes. A vision from your memory into the past, present or future.

Materials: Any paint that you prefer, Paper, Brushes if you have these available. This can easily be done with a pen or pencil.

Procedure:

1. Now that you have drawn out your keyhole you may place your vision inside of it. This could be the keyhole to your future, your past, your mind or your dreams. Get creative! What is your vision?

2. Now you can add color. Use heavy contrast to make sure it stands out, push those darks. Especially if you are doing this with just a pen or pencil.

3. Address the background also. Maybe there are embellishments or wood grain, etc.
