Objective/Learning Target:

Students will

- draw from observation - make several studies of the keyhole
- work on proportion
- explore different visions that relate to their lives

Inspiration: We will look at examples of old ornate keyholes. A vision from your memory into the past, present or future.

Materials: Any paint that you prefer, Paper, Brushes if you have these available. This can easily be done with a pen or pencil.

Procedure:

1. Decide on a Keyhole that you would like to draw. You may find this around your house or online. Examples are on the next slides.
2. Draw your keyhole from observation into an interesting composition. It does not have to be placed in the middle, think outside of the box. The only requirement is that it fills at least half of the paper.
3. Make a collection of photos for references if you need them. Figure out what images you want to draw and fill at least half of the space with the keyhole. Focus on capturing all of the ornate details in the hardware.
4. Start to brainstorm what vision you want to place inside the keyhole.
5. We will finish the lesson tomorrow after you have time to brainstorm, practice and develop a composition.
