Objective/Learning Target:

Students will be able to:

Develop a composition of a portrait that includes collage elements

Bell Ringer: Find art materials that you may have around your house. Here is a link for possible ideas if you do not have painting items at home.

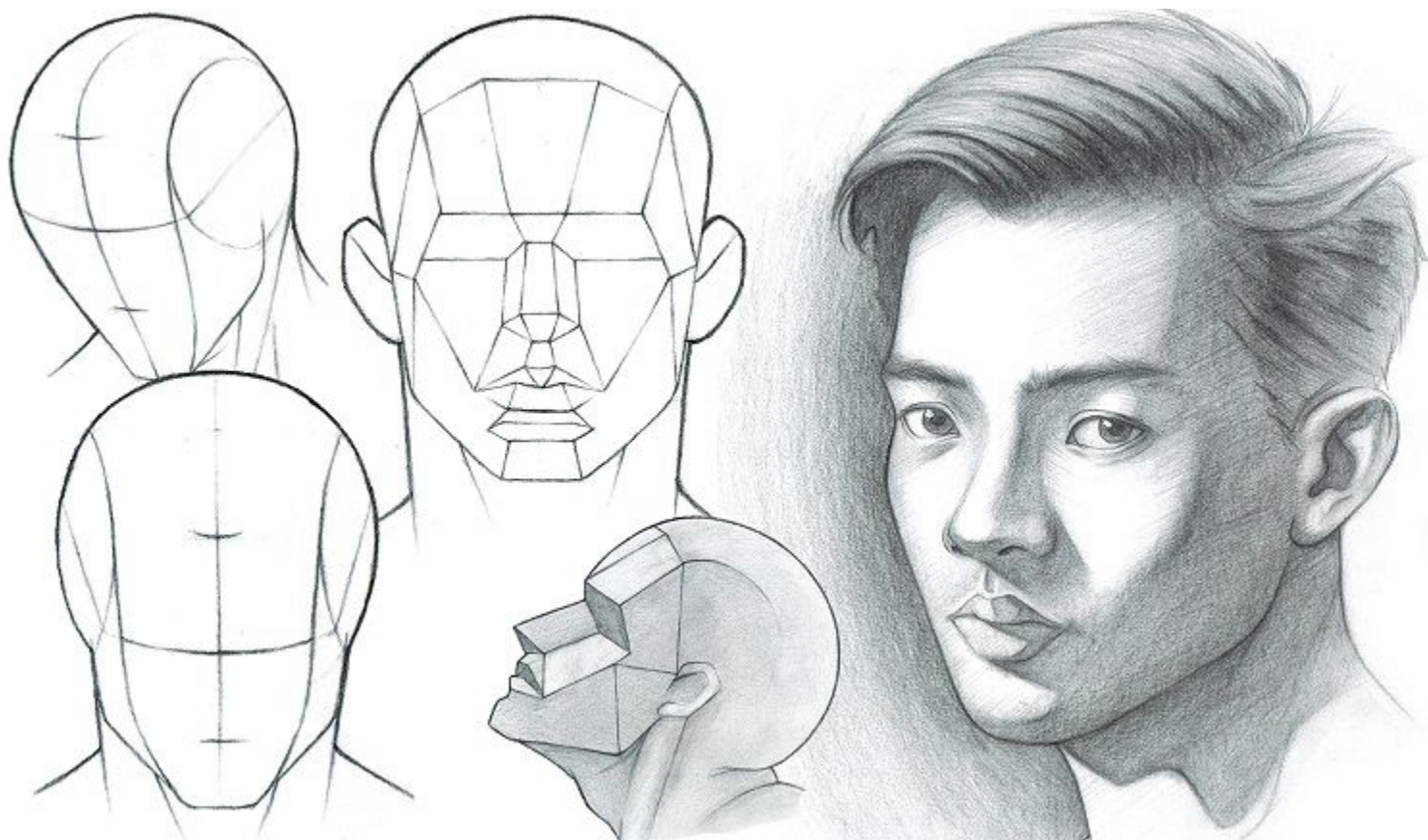

Materials: Newspaper, Magazines and/or Junk Mail, Paper, Modge Podge or glue, paint brush, Water

Procedure:

1. For this project we are going to “paint” using paper. Find a portrait that you want to explore for a composition.
2. Start compiling the colors and collage materials you want to paste down. (At least 3 different colors) Use magazines, newspaper and/or junk mail. You can add acrylics to dye the modge podge and paint it onto paper or newspaper to create a color.
3. Decide on a composition. Create thumbnail sketches and use the rule of thirds to consider placement. Draw your final portrait and simplify it as much as possible.
4. We will finish the lesson tomorrow after you have time to brainstorm, practice and develop a composition.
