### Objective/Learning Target:

Students will be able to:

**Materials:** Newspaper, Magazines and/or Junk Mail, Paper, Modge Podge or glue, paint brush, Water

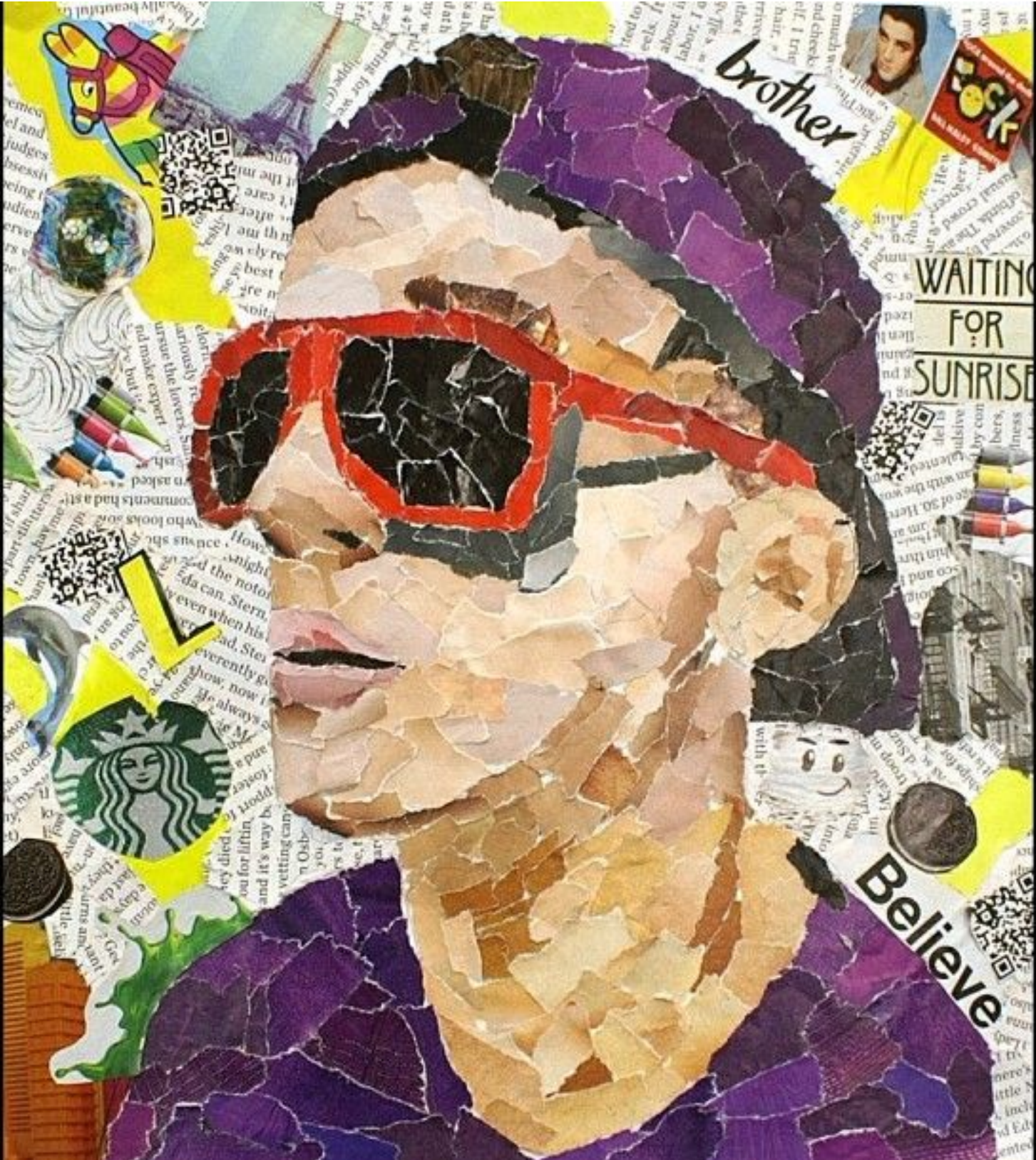
## **Procedure:**

1. Begin collaging. Fill in the shapes with your scraps of paper using modge podge or glue. If you have modge podge then you can use it as a glue AND a sealant on the top. It will give your piece a shiny look.
2. Cut and tear the paper in different shapes and sizes so that it fits with your portrait. You will be challenged to show the lights and darks of your portrait. You must show these highlights and shadows, for this creates high contrast in your piece.
3. You may add marker for some of the details when you finish if you feel it needs some.
