

High School Painting II Lesson: [April 7th]

Objective/Learning Target:

Students will create a composition that exhibits surrealism with an eye.

Goal: Communicate subject matter in original artworks to communicate ideas

Art Vocabulary: Surrealism-A 20th-century literary and artistic movement that attempts to express the workings of the subconscious and is characterized by fantastic imagery and incongruous juxtaposition of subject matter.


Bell Ringer: Find the materials that you might have around your house. Here is a link to possible ideas.


