**Day One: Exploration/Share**

**Objective/Learning Target:** After completing this activity, you will better understand how to decorate a surface of a pliable material like clay.

**Requirements:** The ingredients for cookie dough, or a packaged cookie dough.

**Bellringer/Warm Up:** Consider items in your home that can be used repeatedly to create a pattern or texture. Erasers, jewelry, hardware, forks, the netting that oranges are sold in, etc. could all be used.

**Instructions:** Create a simple cookie dough recipe (like [this one](#) or [this one](#)) or use a packaged cookie dough. If using chocolate chips or nuts, wait to add them until ready to bake.

Once you have the dough, roll or smooth out a fist-sized piece onto a table or counter. Use the objects you found to create textures or patterns in the surface. This is one of the most difficult things for beginners to consider when using clay.

Use combinations of tools. If you wish to start over, wad up the dough and smooth it back out again. Save your best examples by taking pictures, and share them using #isddoesart.

When finished, bake cookies and enjoy.
