Objective:

Students will create a soft sculpture face using found materials.

After looking at the examples above, make a couple of simple pencil sketches before beginning, but expect to make changes as you become familiar with the material you are working with.

Task 1 Using a blanket, towel, t-shirt, or similar material, fold and manipulate the fabric to resemble a face. Experiment with the materials and see which works best. Consider using more than one item to take advantage of adding color to your sculpture, just don't make the challenge too difficult.

Task 2 When you have finished, take a picture and share it using #isddoesart. If you enjoyed the process and feel like you could improve on your design, make more! Just don't forget to share.
