

Sculpting 1 Unit Name: Origami Date: 4/17/2020

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Objective: Use paper as a constructive medium to build a bowl and find ways to decorate it.

Requirements: Paint, ribbon, yarn, glitter, coffee,tea, or other materials to decorate the surface of the bowl.



Bell Ringer: Will the inside and the outside of the bowl be treated differently? Do you have plans for the bowl you created (these aren't meant for food, they are simply decorative).

Lesson/Activity:

- 1. Use whatever materials you have chosen to decorate the bowl. You may also choose to attach items to the surface of the bowl (glue or a glue/water mix work well for this).
- 2. You may choose to seal the surface with a polyurethane, Mod Podge, or something similar. This would help protect the bowl and make it last longer.
- 3. Take a picture of your bowl and share it using #isddoes art.
