Project Submission, Peer Review and Reflection

Objective: The student will increase his/her visual literacy by analyzing their Covid-19 Style Mask designs.

Lesson Activity: Project Submission, Peer Review and MASK CHALLENGE

Once you have completed your mask, create a Twitter or Instagram page to share your creation with your classmates and teachers using the hashtag **#isddoesart**. Teachers will select the best design and declare a winner.

- 1. Take several pictures using a non-distracting background. Think about how to best represent your mask in a single image by considering composition, camera angles, and light source.
- 2. Post ONE photo of your mask.
- 3. Post ONE photo of YOU WEARING YOUR MASK.
- 4. Comment on two classmates pictures using **T.A.G. TELL** the artist something you like, **ASK** the artist a question, or **GIVE** the artist feedback.
- 5. Once final designs are posted using **#isddoesart**, Teachers will announce a winner using the following criteria:

Use of material (creative thought, innovative and unique use of material) Degree of difficulty (time and effort) Resembles a protective mask and covers face. Artistic representation (creative effort, shows creative thought, challenge, and thinking outside the box)

- 9. What movies have characters that wear masks?
