2. Post ONE photo of your mask.
3. Post ONE photo of YOU WEARING YOUR MASK.
4. Comment on two classmates pictures using **T.A.G.**
5. Once final designs are posted using **#isddoesart**, Teachers will announce a winner using the following criteria:

Use of material (creative thought, innovative and unique use of material)

Degree of difficulty (time and effort)

Resembles a protective mask and covers face.

Artistic representation (creative effort, shows creative thought, challenge, and thinking outside the box)
