Lesson Activity: Project Submission

After you have completed your paper and tape cast sculptures, set them up an environment or space.

- Think about how people will be viewing your art in the setting you choose it to be displayed.
- How are you going to present your sculptures in a new way?
- Will you include additional materials to enhance the sculpture? (balloons, christmas lights, color, etc.)
- Will you make a your sculpture something familiar or strange?
- How will the audience interact with your sculpture (walk on, over, under, around, or through?).
- Will your artwork engage the five senses? (Sight, smell, taste, touch, hearing).

Once the installation of your sculptures are complete, take 3-5 pictures. Think about how to best represent your installation in a single image by considering composition, camera angles, and light source.
