Day Three: Creation

Objective/Learning Target:

Students will look at the work of artists using recycled or found objects and materials and explore the creative process of transforming a found object or recycled material into a three dimensional work of art.

Requirements: Scissors, Aluminum can, elmer's glue, wire, marker. Embossing tools: knitting needle, pen or long nail and hammer, hot glue gun. Paper, tape and pencil for templates.
