## Day Three: Creation

## Objective/Learning Target:

Students will design and construct sculptures from recycled corrugated cardboard. Students will explore constructing a variety of forms, problem-solving and risk-taking.

## Requirements:

Cardboard, ruler, tape, utility knife, scissors, glue, paper, cereal boxes, paper, etc. Look around your home to see what materials you can use.

## Instructions:

Today you will begin adapting your sketches as necessary and begin construction!

1. This house should be able to fit inside a $2 \mathrm{ft} \times 2 \mathrm{ft} \times 2 \mathrm{ft}$ box (no measurement longer than 24 ").
2. This house should include at least 1 doorway, 3 windows, roof, and all sides of the outside. Remember that you do not need glue or tape to put material together.
When construction on the walls of your your house is complete, What are some other additions that you could add?

- Does your house have a chimney?
- Is there a tree or flower boxes outside?
- Where is your mailbox?
- What kind of siding and roof does the house have?
- Do you have shutters or curtains on your windows?
