#### Introduction | Application Process | PT | OT | Opportunities Physiotherapy vs. Occupational Therapy

	Physiotherapy	Occupational Therapy
Goal	•Restore movement and mobility •Treats the physical source of the injury (tissues/structures) and helps prevent future injuries	<ul> <li>Restore functional abilities</li> <li>Optimize independence</li> <li>Does not directly treat the injury</li> </ul>
Focus	•Assess ability to roll in bed, sit/stand up, maintain balance, walk, etc.	<ul> <li>Brushing teeth, getting dressed, self-feeding, combing hair, going to the bathroom, etc.</li> <li>Adapting jobs, hobbies, etc.</li> </ul>
Tools	•Stretching, exercise, manipulations, electrical stimulation, heat, cold, etc.	•Same, but OTs differ in their approach and overall goal
Setting	Wide range (e.g. Hospital, health centres, homes)
