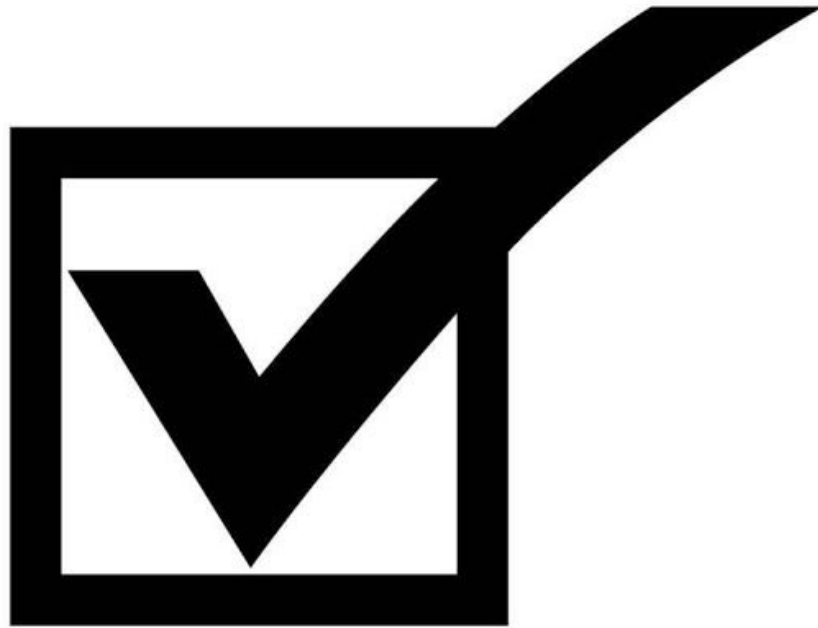

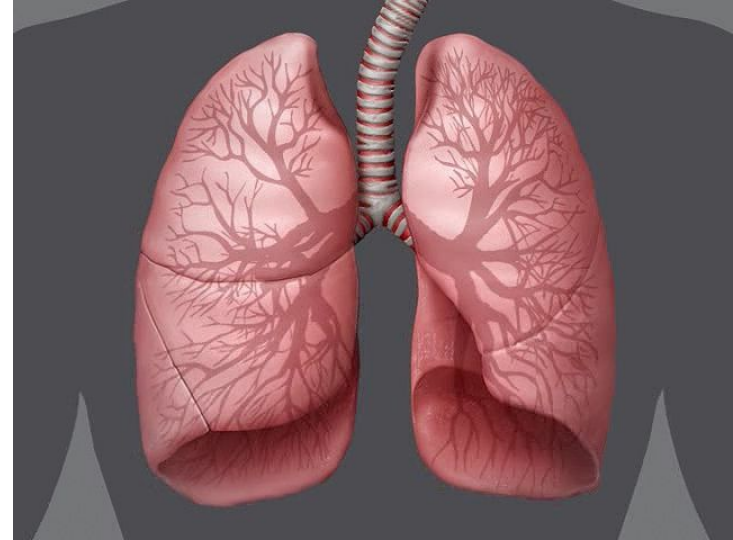

Common Abbreviation Meanings Answers

1) ABG= Arterial Blood Gas

2) AFB= Acid-fast Bacilli

3) ARDS= Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome

4) BAL= Bronchoalveolar Lavage

5) BOOP= Bronchiolitis Obliterans with Organizing Pneumonia

6) CF= Cystic Fibrosis

7) COPD= Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease

8) CPAP= Continuous Positive Airway Pressure

9) CPR= Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

10) CT= Computed Tomography (scan)

11) CXR = Chest X-ray

12) ILD= Interstitial Lung Disease

13) INH= Isoniazid; Isonicotinic Acid Hydrazide

14) MRI= Magnetic Resonance Imaging

15) PFTs= Pulmonary Function Tests

16) PPD = Purified Protein Derivative

17) RAD = Reactive Airway Disease

18) RF= Respiratory Failure

19) SOB=Shortness of Breath

20) TB= Tuberculosis

21) URI= Upper Respiratory Infection

22) V/Q= Ventilation-Perfusion (scan)

23) VATS= Video-assisted Thoracoscopic Surgery
