What is the Function of the Cardiovascular System?


The heart and vessels make up the <u>cardiovascular system</u> to move blood throughout the body.

What is the Function of the Lymphatic System?

The <u>lymphatic system</u> protects the body by filtering microorganisms and foreign particles from the lymph

<u>Lymph</u> is a clear fluid consisting of white blood cells and a few red blood cells.

1) What is the function of the heart?

Muscle that contracts in rhythmic sequences to pump blood throughout the vessels/body

2) What does the abbreviation "RBC" stand for? Red Blood Cell



Vocabulary Terms

- 1) Artery: Blood vessel that carries blood away from the heart
- 2) Vein: Vessel carrying blood to the heart
- 3) Inferior Vena Cava: large vein carrying blood to the heart from lower part of the body
- 4) Superior Vena Cava: large vein carrying blood to the heart from the upper part of the body
- 5) Lymph: Clear Fluid consisting of fluctuating amounts of white blood cells and a few red blood cells

6) Lymph Nodes: small bean-shaped masses of lymphatic tissue that filter bacteria and foreign material from the lymph

7) Lymph Ducts: the largest lymphatic vessels that pick up lymph, proteins and waste from body tissues

8) Lymphatic Vessels: vessels transporting lymph from body tissues to the venous system

Lymphatic System Video Questions/Answers

1) Give 3 things the lymphatic system is comprised of.

Lymph fluid, lymph nodes, lymph vessels, spleen, tonsils, thymus gland

- 2) What are the 3 main functions of the lymphatic system?
 - -Removal of fluid around cells/in cells. Fluid is called Lymph
 - -Fats are absorbed during digestion
 - -Transport antigens that are part of the immune system
