
Objective/Learning Target:



Clear fluid consisting of white blood cells and red blood cells

What is the function of the lymphatic system?

Protects the body from microorganisms or anything that is foreign by bringing antibodies to attack those things.

Heart Attack Video Questions/Answers

- 1) What causes myocardial infarctions (heart attacks)?
- -the heart muscle cannot get enough oxygen due to plaque (fat deposits) that can close off an artery causing cell death
- 2) What are signs of myocardial infarctions?
 - -Chest Pain
 - -Jaw, Back, Abdomen Pain
 - -Nausea
 - -Shortness of breath
 - -Weakness/tiredness
