Write a short medical record of a patient's visit to a general practitioner's office to discuss illness and previous blood work drawn. Make sure you are using medical terms to describe and note information.

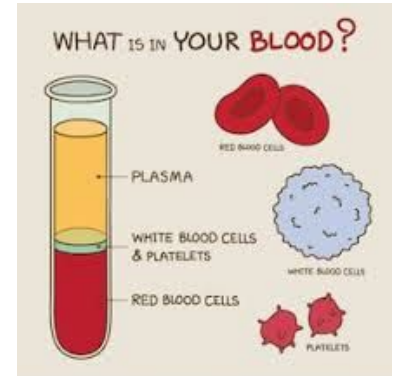
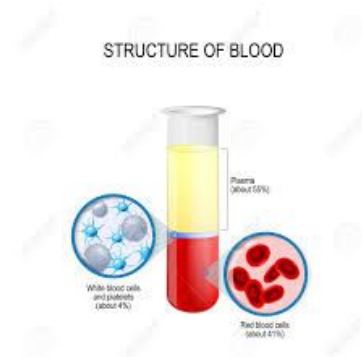
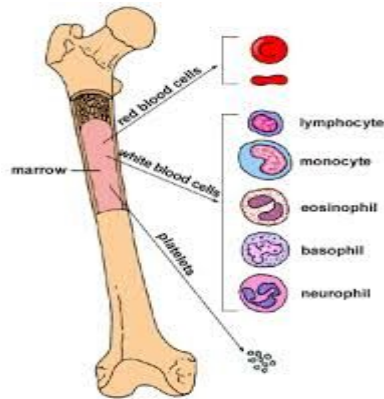
