#### **PROMOTION PLAN**

- 1. Magazine ad to promote the product that is attractive and grabs attention. Include slogan, logo, etc.
- 2. Social media post on at least 2 platforms. To do this, actually create the post and take a screenshot. You don't actually have to post on your social media. You can create it in a google doc. Include images and words.
- 3. The script to a TV commercial for the product. Feel free to video a commercial if you want.
