

Acting 1 & 2 (Introductory Acting) Write Me a Duet Scene! Ms. Hayes, Mr. Meyer, Ms. Yung April 17, 2020

Learning Objective:

The student will now write a short duet scene using two of the three characters that they have created backgrounds for.

Bell Ringer:

Which of the four monologues that you have written do you like the best? Why?

Lesson Steps:

Today, you will use what you have learned about the characters in the Carol Burnett Show Sketch through your character history and monologue work to write a short duet scene where the characters interact and react to each other!

Practice:

- 1. Select either A or B.
 - A. Mama and Eunice
 - B. Eunice and Ed
- 2. Create an idea for a conflict between the two characters.
- 3. Write a short (4 to 5 minute) dialogue for either Mama and Eunice or Eunice and Ed.
- 4. Make certain that you use the words of the characters.
- 5. Make certain you have a beginning, middle, and end to the scene.
- 6. Ask someone at home or send a copy of your script to a friend and ask them if they would read the scene with you. If your friend is in another location, maybe you could FaceTime.
