Analyze script for quality

Bell Ringer/Let's Get Started:

 Share a title of something you have watched this week. Did you like it or dislike it? Why?

Lesson/Activity:

- Art can be interpreted in many ways. When you see a movie/television show/read a book/look at a painting/see a live performance/read the same script of that performance... Your view of what you are looking at can be quite different than the person beside you. The saying "beauty is in the eye of the beholder" rings true in this sense.
- People who have the job of reviewing any art piece do not agree with each other. The reviewers simply give their opinion on the subject and back it up with their reasons as to why they feel that way.
- TASK: You are going to take on the role of a reviewer. You will read a short play and form an opinion on it. Try to envision the play being acted out as you read, as that is the way plays are intended to be viewed.

Practice:

- Read the script
- After reading the script, write a short review of it as though you are giving a short presentation about it on a television interview. Include your rating scale (other reviewers use stars or popcorn bags on a scale that lets the audience know how good it is.) You can use one of those or create your own scale. Write out your review as a script for yourself.
